**About the Workshop**

The Chicago Chapter of the ARS is excited to announce that **Cléa Galhano** has agreed to present our workshop this year. The music will cover an approach to the rhythms, drama and form of the Spanish, Italian and English Renaissance, on through the structure of the German Baroque, to the Latin flavor of recent Brazilian music. The playing level is intermediate to advanced. Bring your recorders, music stand, pencil and enthusiasm! The fee includes Continental breakfast, lunch, refreshments at two breaks, and music for use in the workshop.

**About the Conductor**

**Cléa Galhano**, a Brazilian recorder player, residing in the USA, is known for her performance of early, contemporary and Brazilian music. She has performed as a solo and chamber musician across the USA, Canada, South America and Europe. As chamber collaborator, Ms. Galhano has toured with Marion Verbruggen, and as soloist with the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra conducted by Christopher Hogwood and Nicholas MacGegan. She has recorded for the Dorian, Ten Thousand Lakes and Eldorado Labels. Ms. Galhano recently performed at the prestigious Tage Alter Music Festival in Germany, receiving acclaimed reviews. Ms. Galhano studied in Brazil, at the Royal Conservatory (The Hague), and at the New England Conservatory of Music (Boston), earning a Fulbright scholarship and support from the Dutch government. She is a founding member of Galhano/Montgomery Duo and Belladonna Baroque Quartet, while being an artist in residency at the prestigious Schubert Club in Minnesota. She teaches workshops all over the USA, and has performed in concerts in Rome and in London, where she gave her recital debut at the famous Wigmore Hall. She also served on the national board of the American Recorder Society. Ms. Galhano is a member of the faculty at the St. Paul Conservatory, at McAlester College and at the MacPhail Center for the Arts.

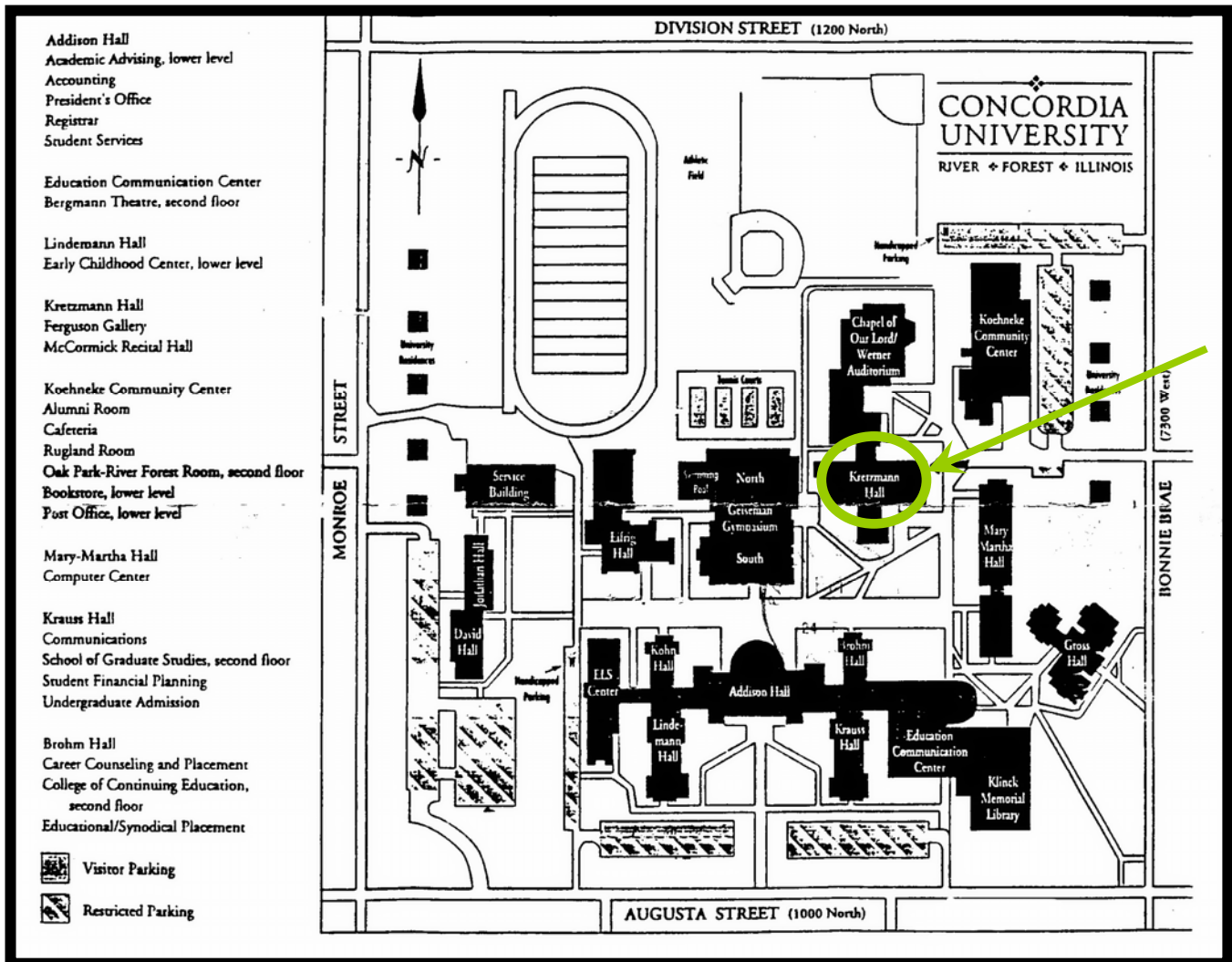

## Directions to Concordia University

The Campus is located less than a half-hour from O'Hare Airport; River Forest is 10 miles west of the Chicago Loop. Concordia is easily reached from the Eisenhower Expressway [I-290]. Exit at Harlem Avenue and go north 2 miles to Augusta Avenue (traffic light); then go one block to Bonnie Brae and turn right (north). Residential street parking is near the campus. **[Please do not use the campus lots.]** Park in this or the next block along Bonnie Brae. *Kretzmann Hall* is about a block west, next to the chapel (note arrow below). Additional parking is available on Division Street. Handicapped parking is also available (see map).
